



Understanding Shipping Methods

Loose Parcel vs. Palletized

Loose Parcel:

- Units are shipped in individual boxes via FedEx or UPS
- Units may arrive faster, but it is unlikely that all units will arrive at once
- A request for signature upon delivery may be available, however call-aheads or delivery appointments are not
- UPS/FedEx tracking does not always accurately reflect estimated delivery date

Palletized - LTL

- Units are palletized and picked up by a truck carrying other shipments (less-than-truckload)
- Your pallets will almost always be delivered at once, with low risk of missing pieces
- Longer delivery times than loose parcel & FTL (below)
- An appointment delivery option is available*

Palletized - FTL

- Units are palletized and picked up by a dedicated truck (full-truckload)
- Truck is routed directly to final destination
- Fastest delivery times, but highest cost. Typically reserved for orders over 5-6 pallets
- An appointment delivery option is available*
